Selection: Please select and prioritize (use 1, 2, 3 etc.) which competitions you would like to be considered for as a coach or manager with the Alberta Team. All coaches will be selected as per the criteria in the Skater Development Bulletin. The number of coaches we send will depend on the number of skaters going to each event. The SSC Competition bulletin outlines these numbers. For Head Coach, preference will be given to those who have a Level 3 (Comp Dev) certification and/or who have had experience coaching at the event they are applying for. For assistant coaches, priority will be given to those who have Intro to Comp NCCP and to those who have not represented Alberta as a coach at these competitions. SSC requires all coaches to have Intro to Comp certification if they are to be in the coaches' box. We require some of our coaches to be present for the Friday afternoon training session the day before racing as well.

Those applying for managers positions would benefit from having Intro to Comp NCCP certification as they may be called upon to coach if needed. Managers will also be considered based on overall experience at the type of competition being applied for. At CACLT and Can West, the manager duties **may** not involve coaching and will focus on communicating with parents/athletes about schedule changes, checking heat postings/changes, distributing helmet covers etc. as well as helping with pre-race preparations. All selected Coaches/Managers will have expenses covered and must sign the AASSA Code of Conduct. We also ask the coaches and managers to complete a Police Information Check that includes a Vulnerable Sector search. For those that do not already have one done for their club, you can contact the AASSA office to ask about possible coverage for that cost.

Please include a coaching resume with your application if you have not coached for Alberta in the last 4 years. .

Deadline: All applications must be in the AASSA office by Jan. 11 for CALT applications and by Feb. 22 for Can West. Successful applicants will be notified by the Skater Development Committee a week after the application deadline based on minimum quota of skaters going. Once final skater numbers are confirmed by SSC 14 days prior to the event, additional coaches may be added.
